<p>SCIENCE (Any Three)</p>	1	<p><u>The Cell: The Fundamental Unit of a Citizen</u> Just as elections form the "bedrock of democracy", the cell is the fundamental unit of every living citizen. <i>The Nucleus (The Central Government):</i> Just as the Central Government comes into shape through the power of</p>

	<p>the vote, the nucleus acts as the "control centre" of the cell, holding the information required to run the organism.</p> <p><i>The Cell Membrane (Security Personnel):</i> At every polling booth, security ensures only authorized people enter. Similarly, the cell membrane is selectively permeable, controlling what enters and exits the cell.</p> <p><i>The Powerhouse (The Voter):</i> The mitochondria provide energy to the cell, much like how the power to change the world resides within each voter.</p>
2	<p><u>. Microorganisms: Friends and Foes of the Festival</u></p> <p>Elections are described as a "festival" involving large populations. In large gatherings, understanding microorganisms is essential for public health.</p> <p><i>Managing the Crowd (Microbes as Foes):</i> In crowded election rallies, communicable diseases caused by viruses and bacteria can spread. Being a "responsible citizen" means following health protocols to prevent the spread of these pathogens.</p> <p><i>Festive Foods (Microbes as Friends):</i> Since elections are a festival, many traditional foods are prepared. Explain the role of Yeast in the process of Fermentation used to make festive snacks.</p> <p><i>Indelible Ink & Science:</i> Research the chemical nature of the ink used on a voter's finger.
